## Role Description

**Post Title:** Healthwatch Essex Ambassador

**Accountable to:** Volunteer Officer

**Location:** Coverage across Essex

**Duration:** up to maximum of 10hrs per month

**Place of work:** Home based (via email, phone, Skype), with occasional meetings.

**Type of Role:** This is a voluntary, unpaid role (reasonable travel expenses will be paid)

Healthwatch Essex is an independent voice for the people of Essex. We collect the views and experiences of people across Essex, and use these to help improve, design and/or support the delivery of local health and social care services in the area.
